NET THE VILLAGE (NtV) is a mosquito net distribution project that aims to help combat malaria by providing treated mosquito nets at no cost to families with children 12 years old and younger. These are critical years for one’s growth and development. It is estimated that almost eight out of ten childhood deaths in the region are related to Malaria. The simple gift of a treated mosquito net helps combat that statistic.

Mission10:14 works with its partners to provide a mosquito net for every qualifying family in the village. Once each family has received a net, the goal to “Net the Village” is reached, and children and their families sleep more safely.
